

Cuchara Art Show Rules and Regulations

Where It's All About the Artists!

Giclees, copies and reproductions of original works of art, whether embellished or not, are not eligible for submission to exhibits. However, fine art prints such as photographs, lithographs, woodcuts, engravings, etchings, screen prints and digital works are acceptable if they are labeled as such and numbered as an edition. Limited edition prints are preferred.

Two Dimensional Art and Framing

- **Artist name and title of artwork must be securely attached or better yet, written on the back of the artwork.**
- All works on paper, including photographs, must be framed. Glass and Plexiglas must be clean inside and out, unscratched, and intact.
- Works on canvas must be framed or have gallery-wrapped, finished edges with no staples
- visible.
- Frames must be in good condition, free of scratches and loose corners.
- Mats must be clean and smoothly cut.
- **A hanging wire must be firmly attached to the back with screw-eyes or D-rings, and the wire not exceeding the top of the frame. Saw tooth hangers will not be accepted**
- Artwork must be completely dry at time of submission.
- Please try to keep the titles short as possible to fit on the display card.
- **If you want to print up the Artwork Take-in Sheet before the show, please make 3 copies of each sheet. A copy of the sheet will be attached to this email. Thank you.**

Artwork previously shown in the Cuchara Art and Show cannot be entered.

A total limit of 8 pieces of work in the accepted mediums (watercolor, oil, acrylic, pastel, pen and ink, charcoal, photography, and sculpture).

We will ask you to number your pieces of art in the order of preference of having them hung in the initial hanging process. As your pieces are sold, the next piece in your chosen order will be hung. We will do our best to follow this process.

We will allow art bins for an additional 8 pieces of unframed and original art, but they must have a different title from any other artwork submitted and it must be entered into our accounts on the Art Take-in forms. Remember, the items in the bins must be listed on your master Art Take-in sheets.

We would love to help you advertise yourself as much as possible during the show. We will have name tags made for you. We will also create a sheet with contact information for all artists.

Statement of Responsibility

All entries are left at the owner's risk—Cuchara Valley Recreation is not responsible for any loss or damage to submitted artwork by any means whatsoever. Cuchara Valley Recreation employees, staff, and volunteers will take all necessary precaution in handling artwork. Bruce the security guard will be present during the overnight hours at the Community Center.
